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CPCWHS1001 - Prepare to work safely in the construction industry - White Card (General Construction Induction Card)

Approved by SafeWork NSW to deliver in NSW

About the course

The short course specifies the mandatory work health and safety training required prior to undertaking construction work. It requires a person to demonstrate personal awareness and knowledge of health and safety legislative requirements in order to work safely and prevent injury or harm to self and others. It covers identifying and orally reporting common construction hazards, understanding basic risk control measures, and identifying procedures for responding to potential incidents and emergencies. It also covers correctly selecting and fitting common personal protective equipment (PPE) used for construction work.

Sessions are trainer-led in group sizes of up to 20 students.

Target Learner

St Moses the Black (SMTB) has designed this practical course for students who are seeking to attain the mandatory work health and safety training required prior to undertaking construction work in New South Wales.

This course is aimed at all new workers carrying out construction work:

- Self-employed persons
- Labourers
- Apprentices
- Trainees

Minimum Entry Requirements:

- Applicants must be over 14 years of age, but applicants under 18 years old must provide evidence of a Parental Consent Form signed off and submitted with application prior to course commencement.
- Applicants must provide 100 points of ID and show this on the day of the course. This means you must provide at least 2 forms of ID which must be sighted on the day of your course before course commencement. For more information, please read the info at;

- Students are required to complete a short language, literacy and numeracy test as part of their enrolment.
- If a student is not confident with their LLN abilities we strongly recommend that they contact us personally prior to the commencement of the course to discuss the appropriateness of the course for them.

The Unique Student Identifier

When studying nationally recognised training a student is required to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). The USI links to an online account that contains all the student's training records and results that have completed from 1 January 2015 onwards. You can either provide your own USI (www.usi.gov.au) or we can assist you.

Please note, a USI is required to receive your certification.

Course Licensing Information

Licensing requirements apply to this unit of competency as regulatory requirements in the NSW jurisdiction. This course supports the attainment of the basic WHS knowledge required prior to undertaking designated work tasks within any of the sectors in the construction industry.

The unit relates directly to the general induction training program specified by the National Code of Practice for Induction for Construction Work (ASCC 2007) this course is provided by St Moses The Black for students who are currently working or intending to work on construction sites in NSW. Students intending to work in other states of Australia must contact Safe Work Australia for these state jurisdictional requirements.

The Course Facts:

Duration: 1 day, 8 hours, with additional time before the course start time

Training is conducted face-to-face, over one day, consisting of 6 hours training and 30 minutes of assessment in a classroom environment. Students must allow an additional 20 minutes prior to course commencement for completion of all necessary paperwork and proof of ID and an additional 30 minutes at the end of the day for assessment marking.
